CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THOS. LEITH

of Murphy, State of Oregon, 97533, has
a right to the use of the waters of Panther Creek, Packers Gulch, and Iron Gulch

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of
irrigation of 11 acres in Tract No. 1, irrigation of 0.25 acre and domestic use
in Tract No. 2, and irrigation of 4.6 acres in Tract No. 3

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from July 22, 1894 for Tract No. 1, 1893 for Tract No. 2,
and April 4, 1902 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per
second for Tract No. 1, 0.03 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 2, and 0.092
cubic foot per second for Tract No. 3.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
