## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RAINBOW WATER DISTRICT &  
CITY OF SPRINGFIELD

of P. O. Box 8, Springfield, State of Oregon, 97477, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Wells No. 1, 2, 3, & 4

a tributary of McKenzie River for the purpose of  
Municipal

under Permit No. G-237 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
March 29, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
5.6 cubic feet per second, being 1.8 c.f.s. from Well No. 1; 1.1 c.f.s. from  
Well No. 2; 1.8 c.f.s. from Well No. 3; 0.9 c.f.s. from Well No. 4

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, T. 17 S., R. 2 W., W. M.,  
No. 1-North 81 degrees 36 minutes East 1447.5 feet, No. 2- North 85 degrees  
18 minutes East 1562.06 feet, No. 3-North 88 degrees 32 $\frac{1}{2}$  minutes East 1681.5  
feet, No. 4-North 88 degrees 41 minutes East 1805.5 feet, All from the NNE  
Corner of P. Comegys DLC 80, Section 29

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
