or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN4 SW4, Section 36. T. 13 S., R. 10 W., W. M., 1320 feet South and 610 feet East from Witness Corner for Meander Corner at NW Corner Lot 13 (SW4 NW4)

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to------of one cubic foot per second per acre,
