CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARY JEAN WILSON

of Route 2, Box 54A, Alsea, State of Oregon, 97324, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Bear Creek for irrigation to be made up by appropriation from Alsea River, provided * a tributary of for the purpose of domestic use for 7 families and irrigation of 0.8 acre

under Permit No. 36463 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 19, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 3, T. 14 S., R. 9 W., W. M., Bear Creek-230 feet South and 2260 feet East; Alsea River-400 feet South and 2490 feet East, both from M.C. at SW Corner, Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & 0.8 acre Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 Section 3
 T. 14 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

* that the total quantity diverted from both sources for irrigation shall not exceed 0.01 c.f.s.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
