## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L. P. MCCUBBIN

of Enterprise, State of Oregon, 97828, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River and Prairie Creek

a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of  
the irrigation of 50.9 acres, domestic, and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 5, at page 183; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from November 12, 1900 for Tract No. 1 and 1889 for  
Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  $1\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per  
acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and there-  
after not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the  
irrigation season for Tract No. 1 and one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre for Tract No. 2;

The point of diversion is located in the Ivanhoe Ditch-SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 7; Craig  
Ditch-NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 31, T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

Tract No. 1  
Wallowa River  
9.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
36.9 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 7  
T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M.

Tract No. 2  
Prairie Creek  
5.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 7  
T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior  
certificate recorded at page 3105, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right  
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources  
Director entered on January 30, 1978, approving transfer application No. 2648.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the  
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
