that the amount of the to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually bend ficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre and one acre foot for each acre of land actually irrigated during any period of 30 days during the irrigation season prior to July 31 st and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre per acre for said lands for the entire remainder of the irrigation season.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
