and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 119; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1865

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-sixtieth of a cubic foot per second per acre during the irrigation season from April 1 to October 1.

The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NE4, Section 22, T. 1 N., R. 12 E., W. M., 440 feet North and 230 feet West from the E4 corner of Section 22.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.8 acres SE4 NE4 1.2 acres NE4 NE4 Section 22 T. 1 N., R. 12 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to describe that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded on page 5706, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 2, 1971, as well as to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by the same order and supersedes certificate 5706.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
