of 23676 S.E. 442 Ave., Sandy , State of Oregon, 97055 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed creek, spring and three reservoirs constructed under Application No. R-49930, Permit No. R-6081 a tributary of Alder Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 59.2 acres

under Permit No. 37424 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 25, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.48 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ % SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, T. 8 S., R. 23 E., W. M.; Reservoir No. 3-50 feet South and 1050 feet West; spring-1430 feet West; Reservoir No. 1-1300 feet South and 2100 feet West, Reservoir No. 2-2100 feet South and 750 feet West, all from the NE Corner, Section 1

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-forthiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from three reservoirs constructed under Permit No. R-6081

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Unnamed Creek & Spring

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
