CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ELWOOD & IONE STANBRO

of Unity, State of Oregon, 97884, has
a right to the use of the waters of S. Fork Burnt River

a tributary of Burnt River for the purpose of
the irrigation of 28.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 134; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from August, 1888

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per
acre during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in
Paragraph 64 of said decree).

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, T. 13 S., R. 36 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:


20.9 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
7.6 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 16
T. 13 S., R. 37 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an
order of the Water Resources Director entered February 16, 1965 and together
with certificate of water right recorded on page 32390, Volume 24, State Record
of Water Right Certificates, supersedes certificate of water right recorded on
page 5885, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
