CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HENRY L. & WANDA G. McALMOND

of 16955 Water Gap Road, Williams, State of Oregon, 97544, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Williams Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 11.2 acres

under Permit No. E-188 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 15, 1913

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Shoudy DLC 38, Section 26, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 230 feet South and 4750 feet East from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 27
T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M.


This certificate is issued to correct and supersede certificate of water right recorded on page 44000, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correctly describe the point of diversion.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
