CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MRS. GUY A. COX, MARVIN B. & EVA L. NOBLE

of Tidewater _____, State of Oregon, 97390, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek

a tributary of Alsea River _____ for the purpose of domestic use for two houses and three cabins

under Permit No. 20187 _____ and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 16, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 27, T. 13 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 27
T. 13 S., R. 10 W., W. M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 24528, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on November 18, 1977.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
