## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** C. G. MCCORMACK

of Rt. 1, Enterprise, State of Oregon, 97828, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
Alder Creek

a tributary of Wallowa River for the purpose of  
supplemental irrigation of 10.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 5, at page 154; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1889

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 acre foot per acre  
during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter  
not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation  
season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations  
contained in said decree.



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an  
order entered June 19, 1939 and together with transfer number C-20 supersedes  
certificate 2977.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
