## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

RICHARD O. RENKEN

of Route 1, The Dalles , State of Oregon, 97058 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Threemile Creek

a tributary of Columbia River the irrigation of 72.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 18062 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 14. 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.9 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_4$  NE $_4$ , Section 22, T. 1 N., R. 13 E., W. M., 1690 feet South and 430 feet East from the  $N_4$  corner of Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigates. A shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.3 acres Lot 2 (NE4 NE4) 8.4 acres Lot 1 (NW4 NE4) 23.0 acres SE4 NE4 25.6 acres SE4 NE4 Section 22 T. 1 N., R. 13 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows: That part of the above described land lying East of Threemile Creek, all in Section 22, Township 1 North, Range 13 East, W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 11, 1964 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 21385, Volume 15, State Record of Water

Right Certificates.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
