that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1888 for 8 acres and 1911 for
24 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one curic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

8 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-one: and 24 acres in the Northeast cuarter of Southwest quarter of Section Eight, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Tillamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
