CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT KAUER, JR.

of Rt. 3, Box 546, Cornelius , State of Oregon, 97113 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of East Dairy Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply from East Dairy Creek to be made up by appropriation from unnamed drainageway and * a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 147.1 acres

under Permit No. 35818 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 15, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE½ NW½, as projected within Cornelius, Jr. DLC 42, Section 9, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M., East Dairy Creek - 400 feet North and 300 feet West; Reservoir - 400 feet North; both from center of Section 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5784,

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conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. .

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* reservoir constructed under Application No. R-49065, Permit No. R-5784, provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second
