CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CROCKER BROTHERS

of Rt. 1, Box 617, Monroe, State of Oregon, 97456, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Martins Lake and Old Channel Willamette River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 8.9 acres and supplemental irrigation of 102.5 acres

under Permit No. 38430 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 20, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.28 cubic feet per second, being 0.11 c.f.s. from Martins Lake and 1.28 c.f.s. from Old Channel Willamette River

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 14, T. 14 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Martins Lake-1170 feet North and 100 feet East; Old River Channel-20 feet North and 250 feet East, both from the SW Corner, Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
