of 680 Blue Cross Bldg., Portland , State of Oregon, 97201 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Fork Alsea River

a tributary of Alsea River irrigation of 6.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 17341 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 6, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN_4 , as projected within Fudge DLC 38, Section 18, T. 14 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 1800 feet South and 2900 feet East from the NW Corner, Fudge DLC 43.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 22, 1971, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 24390, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
