## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. E. MULLINS

of Box 118, Otis, State of Oregon, 97368, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Deer Creek and two unnamed springs

a tributary of Salmon River for the purpose of irrigation of 3.5 acres and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 31244 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 10, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 c.f.s. from Deer Creek for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. from Spring No. 1 and 0.005 c.f.s. from Spring No. 2 for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20, T. 6 S., R. 10 W., W. M., Spring No. 1 - 130 feet North and 50 feet West; Spring No. 2 - 430 feet North and 140 feet West; Deer Creek - 610 feet North and 130 feet West; all from the SE corner of Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 3.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 20  
T. 6 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
