CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WARMSPRINGS IRRIGATION DISTRICT

of Box 667, Vale, State of Oregon, 97918, has
a right to the use of the waters of Malheur River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of
the irrigation of 44.5 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1881

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1½ acre feet per acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre foot per acre in any 30 day period after June 1st, of each year, or 3 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 23, 1978, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 6970, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
