CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DONALD L. KING

of Rt. 2, Box 171, Dallas, State of Oregon, 97338, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Teal Creek and Spring

a tributary of Luckiamute River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 14.5 acres

under Permit No. 38101 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 11, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.185 cubic foot per second, being 0.18 c.f.s. from Teal Creek for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. from spring for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, both as projected within Brown DLC 46, T. 8 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Teal Creek-1100 feet South and 160 feet East; Spring-1660 feet South and 1000 feet West, both from the Center of Section 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 1.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Domestic & 13.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 All as projected within Brown DLC 46
 Section 27
 T. 8 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
