CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

PUBLISHERS PAPER COMPANY

of 419 Main St., Oregon City, State of Oregon, 97045, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Price Creek, unnamed stream and 2 reservoirs constructed under Permit No. R-5889

a tributary of Luckiamute River for the purpose of maintaining 2 reservoirs for fire protection

under Permit No. 36396 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from Price Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed stream

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, T. 10 S., R. 6 W., W. M.; No. 1-1240 feet South and 4230 feet East; No. 2-1195 feet South and 4050 feet East; No. 3-1105 feet South and 4330 feet East, all from the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
