CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WALTER L. & MARY B. MCGREW

of Star Route, Box 195, Umpqua , State of Oregon, 97486 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River and spring stream

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 5.5 acres

under Permit No. 37687 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.055 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 c.f.s. from Umpqua River for irrigation, and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation from spring stream

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 32, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M., River-870 feet North and 700 feet East; 290 feet South and 1800 feet East; stream-860 feet South and 1250 feet East, all from the SW Corner Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



Domestic & 1.0 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

Umpqua River
0.9 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
3.6 acres Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 32
T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
