CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That . DAVIS WILCOX of Haines, Oregon. AMANDA C. MOORE, SUSAN W. MOORE AND CECILE W. MOORE of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Sand Creek, Rock Creek, Pine Creek and Willow Creek, tributaries of Powder River for the purpose of the irrigation of 468.5 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1874 for 40 acres and 1865 for 40 acres in Tract No. 1: 1897 for 25 acres and 1903 for 133.5 acres in Tract No. 2 and 1906 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1 from Sand Creek and Rock Creek: 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-two, Township Seven South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2 from Pine Creek: 38.5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Eight, Township Eight South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon. (NOTE: 100 acres of this land has a supplementary right from Willow Creek through the Wilcox No. 2 ditch, under date of 1906)

Tract No. 3 from Willow Creek: 10 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Seven: 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Nine: 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 20 acres in the South half of Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Eight and 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Ten, Township Eight South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
