CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DALE H. ROGERS

of Rt. 3, Box 393, Grants Pass , State of Oregon, 97526 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applepate River

a tributary of Rogue River irrigation of 6.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 21565 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 30. 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, Section 8, Wilderville Ditch-NW4 SW4 Section 15, 650 feet South and 890 feet East from the W4 Corner, Section 15, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.6 acres SW4 NE4 3.6 acres SE4 NW4 Section 8 T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 27350, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 8, 1974, approving transfer application No. 2980, as well as to confirm the change in point of diversion approved by the same order.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the w *er for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
