a tributary of Pudding River irrigation of 40.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27374 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 5, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, as projected within S. Cox DLC 45, Section 33, T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.; 440 feet South from the NE Corner S. Cox DLC 45

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right

is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.4 acres NW4 NE4
19.4 acres SW4 NE4
1.9 acres NE4 NW4
4.3 acres SE4 NW4
All as projected within S. Cox DLC 43
Section 33

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 25, 1974 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 31805, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
