CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GRANT E. STURM

of Route 1, Box 409, Boring, State of Oregon, 97009, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5859

a tributary of Johnson Creek for the purpose of fish culture and irrigation of 0.2 acre

under Permit No. 36170 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 2, 1970 for fish culture and August 29, 1972 for irrigation that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for fish culture and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, T. 1 S., R. 4 E., W. M., 500 feet North and 1250 feet West from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5859, and shall be further limited to appropriation from direct flow during the period between December 1 and June 1 of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fish culture & 0.2 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 22
T. 1 S., R. 4 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
