CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ROSE WILSON & H. VAN ORDHEIM

of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Powder River, tributary of Snake River and Beaver Creek, tributary of Snake River for the purpose of the irrigation of 305 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 321; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1873 for 207.1 acres; 1891 for 56.4 acres and 1873 for 61.5 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/10 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

21 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 45 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Sixteen; 16.7 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 2 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 49 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 30 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 23.4 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 23.2 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 2.3 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Eighteen; 5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Nineteen; 22.7 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 28.3 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Seventeen, Township Ten South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

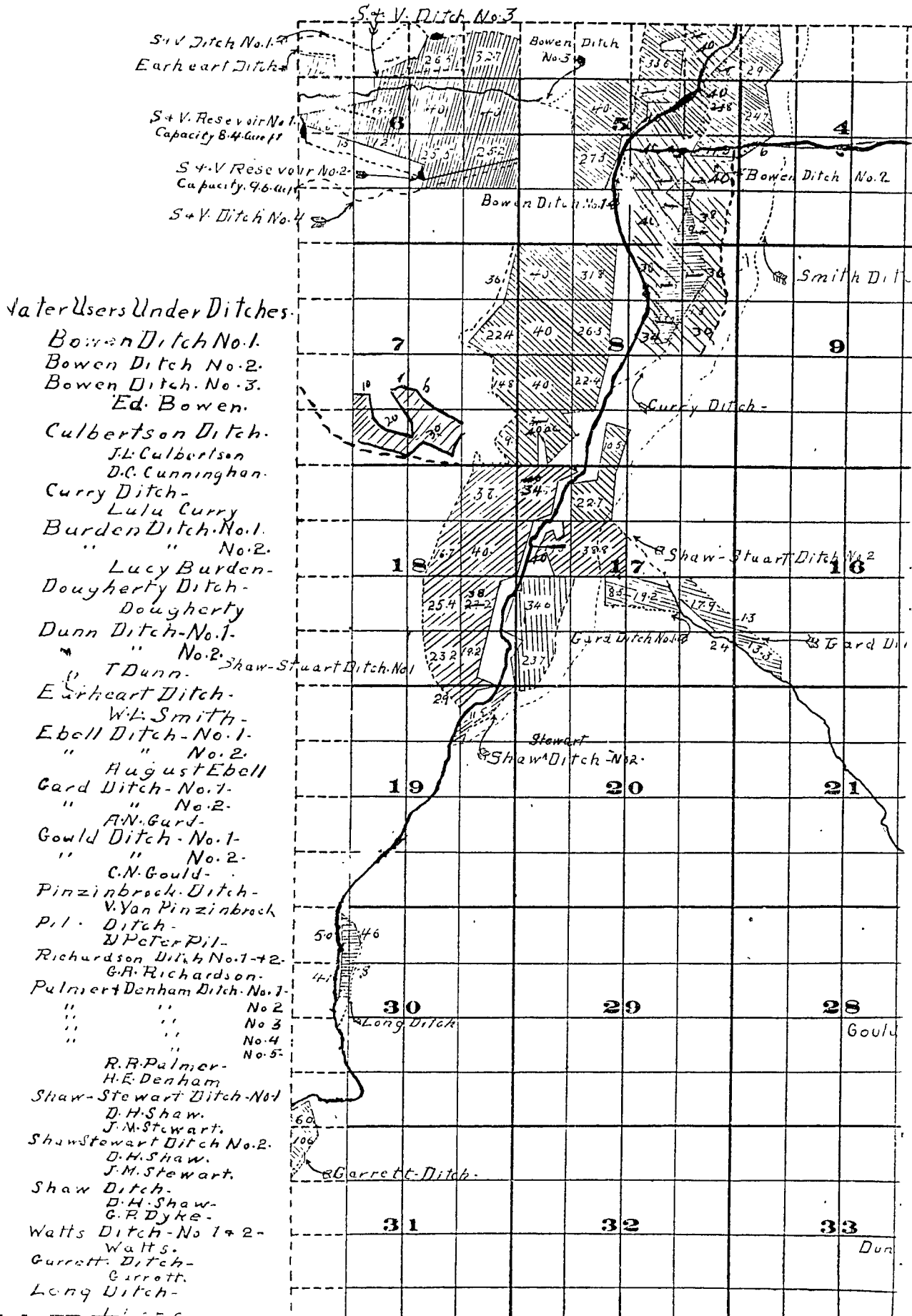
