## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CARL L. & ANITA J. HARRIS

of Rt. 1, Box 113, Two Acre Land, Walla Walla, State of Washington, 99362, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Elkington Wells No. 1 and No. 2

a tributary of Dugger Creek supplemental irrigation of 17.65 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-2405 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second, being 0.12 c.f.s. from Well No. 1 and 0.10 c.f.s. from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NW4, Section 30, T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M., No. 1-1280 feet South and 970 feet East; No. 2-460 feet South and 170 feet East; both from the NW Corner, SW4 NW4, Section 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $4\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Well No. 1 9.2 acres SW4 NW4

Well No. 2 8.45 acres SW4 NW4 Section 30 T. 6 N., R. 35 E., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 33483, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on January 30, 1978. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
