## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**OREGON STATE PARKS AND RECREATION  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

of Vick Bldg., 525 Trade St., S.E., Salem, State of Oregon, 97310, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Coquille River  
general park use

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-5290 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 29, 1970 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second, being 0.06 c.f.s. from each well

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 18, T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M., North Well-South 41 degrees 50 minutes West 1574 feet; South Well-South 35 degrees 38 minutes West 1886 feet, both from the NE Corner, Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


