CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. I. EVEREST

of Langlois, State of Oregon, 97450, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Davis Creek and Pond Branch

a tributary of Croft Lake for the purpose of irrigation of 29.2 acres

under Permit No. 20725 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 10, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 cubic foot per second, being 0.28 c.f.s. from Davis Creek and 0.09 c.f.s from Pond Branch

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the S 1/2 NW 1/4, Section 13, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, and NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 14, T. 30 S., R. 15 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and all that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ lying North of a line running South 67 degrees 45 minutes East from the NW Corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, Township 30 South, Range 15 West, W.M. Also the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, all the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying West of the State Highway of Section 13, Township 30 South Range 15 West, W.M. Also beginning 204.9 feet East of the SW Corner of the said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 13; thence South 63 degrees 30 minutes East 103.6 feet; thence North 83 degrees 15 minutes East 219.1 feet; thence South 66 degrees 37 minutes East 466.8 feet to the West boundary of the State Highway; thence along said West boundary northerly to a point East of beginning; thence West to beginning.


This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on page 21790, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to describe the use of water.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
