CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

LE ROY O. AND/OR ELAINE I. NATE

of 103 Cypress St., Boise, State of Idaho, 83705, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Creek and spring

a tributary of Salmon River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.4 acre and domestic use for two families

under Permit No. 34454 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 10, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation from Little Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use from spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T. 6 S., R. 10 W., W. M., Creek-1340 feet North and 1110 feet East; Spring-1180 feet North and 1160 feet East; both from the SW Corner, Section 25

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & 0.3 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.1 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 25
T. 6 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
