## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** H. E. MC GRAW

of 150 College Way, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, 97116, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Mendenhall Creek and West Dairy Creek

a tributary of West Dairy Creek and Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 50.0 acres

under Permit No. 12697 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 23, 1937

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.626 cubic foot per second, being 0.238 c.f.s. from West Dairy Creek and 0.388 c.f.s. from Mendenhall Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 5, T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W. M., Mendenhall Creek-1000 feet South and 800 feet East, 1020 feet South and 500 feet East; West Dairy Creek-500 feet South and 640 feet West, 1320 feet South and 700 feet West, all from the W $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

21.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	0.1 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
10.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	13.6 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$


This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on page 19994, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to include the use of water.
