CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROBERT E. KYLE

of Rt. 4, Box 1077, Roseburg, State of Oregon, 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed creek with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed creek to be made up by appropriation from spring area provided that the total quantity* a tributary of Lookingglass Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 1.0 acre

under Permit No. 36238 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 2, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Flemoy DLC 54, Section 32, T. 27 S., R. 7 W., W. M., Both Unnamed Stream & Spring Area-400 feet South and 1130 feet West from the Center, Section 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
As projected within Flemoy DLC 54
Section 32
T. 27 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

* diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.01 c.f.s.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
