CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That E. A. AUGUSTUS,

of Richland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Powder River, and POWDER RIVER, for the purpose of irrigation of 200 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878 for eighty acres from Eagle Creek; 1901 for 120 acres from Powder River;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

From Eagle Creek: forty acres in the Southwest quarter of North-east quarter; forty acres in Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-five; From Powder River: forty acres in Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; forty acres in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; forty acres in Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section twenty-five; all the above described lands being within Township Nine South of Range Forty-five East, Willamette Meridian, Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
