CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatESTATE OF ROY MORRIS & MRS. MILDRED
ENGMAN

of Box 75, Little Butte Star Rt., Eagle Point, State of Oregon, 97524, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Knutzen Gulch and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1221

a tributary of Little Butte Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 30.0 acres

under Permit No. 20559 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 13, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.375 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 35 S., R. 1 E., W. M., Stream-30 feet South and 550 feet West; Reservoir-480 feet South and 2790 feet West, both from the E $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1221

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:
The N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 36 South, Range 1 East, W.M., containing 80 acres, more or less, according to the U. S. Government Survey thereof; also: the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the East 13 acres of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 35 South Range 1 East, W.M., containing 253 (should be 233) acres, more or less, together with all water and ditch rights pertaining to either or both of said tracts of land.

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on page 23155, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to identify the use of water.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
