## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**                      MARYS PEAK VENEER, INC.

of c/o T. J. Starker, Corvallis                      , State of Oregon, 97330                      , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Marys Peak Veneer Well

a tributary of Oak Creek                      for the purpose of maintenance of log pond

under Permit No. G-271                      and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 28, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Trapp DLC 56, Section 32, T. 11 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 12 3/4 chains South and 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  chains East from the NW Corner, Trapp DLC 56

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
