CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CITY OF RAINIER

of Rainier, State of Oregon, 97048, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Fox Creek and Nice Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of domestic supplies

under Permit No. 674-675 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 20, 1911 for Fox Creek and March 31, 1911 for Nice Creek that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.65 cubic foot per second, being 0.5 c.f.s. from Fox Creek and 0.15 c.f.s. from Nice Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Fox Creek-SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 28; Nice Creek-SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20, T. 7 N., R. 2 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic Supply for the City of Rainier, in Columbia County, Oregon.

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on page 2308, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, so as to correct the quantity of water.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
