CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RIMROCK WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT C/O DANIEL JOSEFOVSKY

of 20070 Beaver Lane, Bend, State of Oregon, 97701, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Deschutes River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of group domestic use for 21 families

under Permit No. 28205 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 18, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 29, T. 16 S., R. 12 E., W. M., 140 feet due East from the SE Corner, Lot 12, Deschutes River Homesites Rimrock Addition

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

Provided that the right to use of water is limited to the non-irrigation season from November 1 to April 1 of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29 T. 16 S., R. 12 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows: Lots 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 21, 22, 25, 26, Deschutes River Homesites, Rimrock Addition.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
