CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Glide, State of Oregon, 97443, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek

a tributary of Little River for the purpose of domestic use for two families

under Permit No. 17946 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 26, 1947 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 27 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 1900 feet North and 650 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is part of the property described as follows: All the land West of Little River located in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 27 S., R. 2 W., W. M., consisting approximately 10 acres, more or less. This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on page 21448, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to correctly describe the point of diversion. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
