CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MRS. AGNES JONES

of Elkton, State of Oregon, 97436, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River, Wilson Creek and unnamed creek

a tributary of Umpqua River
irrigation of 31.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 18453 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 23, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.39 cubic foot per second, being 0.21 c.f.s. from Umpqua River, 0.11 c.f.s. from Wilson Creek and 0.07 c.f.s. from unnamed creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 4, Lot 6 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 4, Lot 10 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 23 S., R. 7 W. W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


