CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That G. H. BROOKS ,

of Richland, , State of Oregon, . . . has a right to the use of the waters of EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Powder River, for the purpose of irrigation of 60.2 acres of land,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six , at page 291 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1881 for 10.2 acres; July 12, 1900 for fifty acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decrees.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Ten acres in Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirteen, Township Nine South of Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon; 0.2 acre in Lots Seven and Eight, Duffey's North Addition to Richland, Baker County, Oregon; Forty acres in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; and Ten acres in Southwest quarter of Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty, Township Nine South of Range Forty-six East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
