CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

BUMBLE BEE SEAFOODS, A DIVISION OF CASTLE & COOKE, INC., AND NICK BEGLERIES

of P. O. Box 60, Astoria, State of Oregon, 97103, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two unnamed creeks, and Beaver Dam Creek

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of domestic use for nine families, and commercial use at boat dock

under Permit No. 38631 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 12, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, water to be diverted from Unnamed Creek No. 1; when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Unnamed Creek No. 1, to be made up by appropriation of water from Unnamed Creek No. 2; and Beaver * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Lot 3 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4), Lot 4 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 5, T. 8 N., R. 6 W., W. M.; No. 1-1147.6 feet South and 641.5 feet East from the meander corner between Sections 5 and 6; No. 2-2110 feet North and 2642.2 feet West; No. 3-1914.9 feet North and 2182.1 feet West, both from the meander corner between Sections 4 and 5

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- Domestic Lot 4 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4)
- Domestic & Commercial Use Lot 2 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4)
- Domestic Lot 3 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4)
- Section 5
- T. 8 N., R. 6 W., W. M.

* Dam Creek.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
