## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN V. NORTHAM

of 84674 Cloverdale Rd., Creswell , State of Oregon, 97426 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek when available, with any deficiency in the available supply from Bear Creek to be made up by appropriation from Coast Fork Willamette River \* a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 110.3 acres and supplemental irrigation of 116.3 acres

under Permit No. 34412 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.94 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 NE4, as projected within Littrel DLC 71, Lot 2 (NE4 NW4), & NE4 SW4, as projected within Callison DLC 50, Section 6, T. 18 S., R. 2 W., W. M.; Bear Creek-1110 feet North and 700 feet East; 2020 feet North and 800 feet West; Coast Fork Willamette River-1570 feet South and 630 feet West, all from the SW Corner, Littrel DLC 71

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
