## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**      CARL S. & PATRICIA M. LINGO

of 27579 High Pass Rd., Junction City, State of Oregon, 97448, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Long Tom River and Fern Ridge Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 252.3 acres

under Permit No. 32715 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 12, 1967 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.85 cubic foot per second from Long Tom River and 556.85 acre feet from Fern Ridge Reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 35, T. 15 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 2, T. 16 S., R. 5 W., W. M.; Reservoir: NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 4, T. 17 S., R. 5 W., W. M., River No. 1-2070 feet North and 870 feet East; No. 2-540 feet South and 250 feet East, both from the SW Corner, Section 35

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1625 and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract No. 14-06-100-6030 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


