This Is to Certify, That

of River Rd., Box 570, Yachats , State of Oregon, 97498 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Spring Creek for irrigation to be made up by appropriation from Yachats River, * a tributary of Yachats River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 7.2 acres

under Permit No. 36462 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 19, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.05 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $_{4}$ SE $_{4}$, Section 2, T. 15 S., R. 11 W., W. M., Spring Creek-160 feet North and 50 feet West; Yachats River-490 feet North and 940 feet West; 790 feet North and 510 feet West; 950 feet North and 125 feet West, all from the SE Corner, Section 2

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
