that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree:

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Twenty-four acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; Forty acres in Southeast quarter of Northeast Quarter of Section Fourteen, Township Nine South of Rango Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.
