of 17792 River Rd., NE, St. Paul , State of Oregon, 97137 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Mission Creek and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5248

a tributary of Champoeg Creek irrigation of 5.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 39226 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 11, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Pump: SE_4^1 NW $_4$, as projected within Hickey DLC 67, Section 17; Dam: Lot 7 (SE_4^1 SE $_4^1$), Section 8, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M., Pump: 890 feet North and 690 feet West from the SE Corner, Hickey DLC 67; Dam: South 85 degrees West 380 feet from the NW Corner, Pettier DLC 92

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to One-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5248

and shal

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.2 acres SE¼ NW4
As projected within Hickey DLC 67
Section 17
T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
