CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAVID MITCHELL COX

of 604 N.E. 8th, Gresham, State of Oregon, 97030, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Johnson Creek for the purpose of cannery

under Permit No. G-6027 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 12, 1974

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.3 cubic feet per second from Well No. 1 with any deficiency in the available supply from Well No. 1 to be made up by appropriation from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4; NE 1/4 NW 1/4; both as projected within James Powell DLC 58, Section 10, T. 1 S., R. 3 E., W. M., Well No. 1-760 feet South and 2380 feet West; Well No. 2-400 feet South and 2680 feet West; both from the NE Corner, Section 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Both as projected within James Powell DLC 58
Section 10
T. 1 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
