CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. C. CUNDIFF

of Richland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of LITTLE EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Eagle Creek, and EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Powder River, for the purpose of irrigation of 115.3 acres of land.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1865 for 115 acres; 1881 for 0.3 acre;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Twenty acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; Twenty-nine acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; thirty acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter, thirty-six acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-six, Township Nine South, Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian; 0.3 acre in Lots Seven, Eight, Nine, of Block two, Usher's West Addition to the town of Richland, Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
