CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That **W. J. DENSLEY, and MARGARET L. DENSLEY,**

of **Richland**, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of **EAGLE CREEK**, a tributary of Powder River,  
for the purpose of irrigation of **112 acres of land;**

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
**Baker** County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order  
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume **six**, at page **291**; ;  
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from **1885 for 22 acres; 1877 for  
forty acres; 1878 for forty acres; 1879 for ten acres;**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **one-fortieth of one  
cubic foot per second per acre**, and shall be subject to all other conditions and  
limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

**Two acres in Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Fifteen;**  
**Five acres in Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Fourteen;** **fifteen**  
**acres in Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter;** **ten acres in Southeast quarter of**  
**Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-two;** **forty acres in Northeast quarter of**  
**Northwest quarter;** **forty acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Sec-**  
**tion twenty-three, Township Nine South, Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meri-**  
**dian, in Baker County, Oregon.**

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
